

## Karl Aage Rasmussens fuldstændiggørelse af Schumanns Fjerde Klaversonate

### *Studiepartitur*

Karl Aage Rasmussens færdiggørelse af de to satser af Schumanns sonate er netop udkommet på forlaget Wilhelm Hansen. Med forfatterens tilladelse har vi imidlertid fået mulighed for at trykke det i *PubliMus* på en måde, der løbende lader læseren – lytteren – følge med i, hvad der originalt er Schumann, og hvad der er tilføjet af Karl Aage Rasmussen.

Princippet er enkelt. Noder på hvid baggrund figurerer originalt i Schumanns skitser, noder på grå baggrund er Karl Aage Rasmussens tilføjelser.
